The regular meeting of the Council of the Village of Luckey held on March 5th, 2025 at 7:00 p.m. and was held in the Municipal Building. The following members were present: Councilpersons: Mike McNulty, Alison Okenka, Pat Covarrubias, Don Brickner, Mayor Cory Panning, Village Administrator Randy Bielinski, Jacob Sandwisch, and Fiscal Officer Barb Rizzo. Absent from the meeting was Michael Franklin and Richard Heilman.

The mayor led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The mayor thanked all of the visitors for coming to the meeting.

The following visitors were present at the meeting: Douglas Predmore, Andrew Predmore, and Deb Reid.

There were no comments by the visitors.

Pat Covarrubias made a motion to accept the minutes from regular meeting that was held on February 19th, 2024 at 7:00 p.m. Mike McNulty seconds the motion. Vote: Roll call- Mike McNulty-yes, Alison Okenka-yes, Don Brickner-yes, Pat Covarrubias-yes, motion carried.

Police Chief- Randy Bielinski handed out the end of the month report for review and stated that Adrian Zellin is doing a great job.

Maintenance- Randy Bielinski presented material related to two purchases that will need to be made for the maintenance department.

The first purchase will be from Bauman Ford, a F600 Chassis with snow package from Kalida. The purchase will be in the amount of \$147,220.96.

Pat Covarrubias made a motion to accept the Bauman Ford, F600 Chassis with snow package from Kalida in the amount of \$147,220.96. Pat Covarrubias also stated to look into financing for the purchases as options. Mike McNulty seconds the motion. The second purchase will be from Best Equipment, a Leaf-VAC with a self-contained until, the estimate cost will be \$70,000 but could be a little higher due to the quote being older.

Pat Covarrubias made a motion to accept the purchase from Best Equipment of a Leaf-VAC with a self-contained unit, at the estimated cost of \$75,000 to cover any change in price from the original estimation. Pat Covarrubias states to look into financing for the purchase as an option. Mike McNulty seconds the motion. Village Administrator- Randy Bielinski stated that the TD Engineering completed a walk through for the streets and quoted \$5440.00 for the Professional Services Proposal Number P2025010, Luckey Pavement Evaluation.

The one-year renewal with N.A.T. will have a 3 percent rate increase.
