Village of Luckey, Ohio Water System Project – January 2024 update

- On January 19, 2024, the Village of Luckey met with leaders at the EPA to discuss the processes of activating a public water system and the summary of requirements for public water systems.
- The meeting was very productive, with the EPA expressing no concerns for the Village of Luckey to continue evaluating a surface water source (the Quarry property) as part of the general plan that will be created and submitted for their review. The EPA does require at least three options to be evaluated with one of those being connection to a regional system. Regionalization will be included in the overall general plan. There are currently 44 surface water public water systems in the Northwest District, which covers the 24 counties in Northwest Ohio.
- The EPA does offer funding options, which the Village will explore when that phase of the project is determined.
- The EPA will be an integral part of the Village’s plans toward public water as the general plan, feasibility, and planning continues.
- The Village of Luckey is still waiting for Judge Mary “Molly” Mack to review all the items submitted to the Court to make her ruling on the purchase of the Quarry/property in litigation.
