

The Minutes of the Council of the

The Regular meeting of the Council of the Village of Luckey held on October 6, 2021 meeting at 7:00 p.m. in the Municipal Building The following members were present: councilperson, Donald Brickner, Michael Franklin, Lisa Skriba, Mike McNulty, Mayor Cory Panning, Village Administrator Randy Bielinski, and Fiscal Officer Connie Heflin. The Mayor led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Michael Franklin made a motion to accept the minutes from the Regular meeting held on September 1, 2021 with the following changes: Jessica Sic changed to Jessica Reynolds. The Mayor recognized four visitors Harley and Carolyn Ashby, Jim Bell and Tim Snyder.

Harley Ashby spoke about the difficulties of obtaining supplies to built a pickle ball court for his Eagle project and feels that the cost is prohibited to continue. He has a replacement project to replace the pickle ball court. Mr. Ashby would like to built a Gaga Ball Pit for a new project at Veterans Park. He explained what a Gaga Ball Pit is and the cost involved to built one would be approximately \$ 1,500.00.
