The Minutes of the Council of the Village of Luckey

The Regular meeting of the Council of the Village of Luckey held on April 19th, 2023 at 7:04 p.m. was in the Municipal Building. Lisa Skriba made mention on May 12th, the garden club will be having the annual hanging basket sale at the community garden, more information to come.

Lisa Skriba stated that on May 20th, the garden club will be performing clean-up in where mulch will be placed at the Triangle, Basic Park, and the Town Hall. The mulch will cost \$363.75.
