

The Minutes of the Council of the  
Village of Luckey

The Regular meeting of the Council of the Village of Luckey held on August 3, 2022 meeting at 7:00 p.m. in the Municipal Building. The following members were present: councilperson Michael Franklin, Lisa Skriba, Donald Brickner, Richard Heilman, Mike McNulty, Village Administrator Randy Bielinski, Mayor Cory Panning, and Fiscal Officer Connie Heflin. Absent was councilperson Patricio Covarrubias.

The Mayor led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Michael Franklin made a motion to pay the bills as presented. Mike McNulty seconds the motion. Vote: Roll Call: Michael Franklin-yes, Richard Heilman -yes, Lisa Skriba-yes, Donald Brickner-yes, Mike McNulty-yes, motion carried.

Michael Franklin made a motion to accept the minutes from the Regular meeting held on July 22, 2022 as read: Mike McNulty second the motion. Vote: Roll Call- Michael Franklin-yes, Richard Heilman-yes, Lisa Skriba-yes, Donald Brickner-yes, Mike McNulty -yes, motion carried.

Richard Heilman brought up Ordinance # 824 (An Ordinance Amending Ordinance no 820 Which Requires an Agreement to Petition for Annexation to the Village of Luckey Before Extending Utility Services to property outside the Village for the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading. Visitors Shelly Kellermier and Tim Snyder were recognized. Ms. Kellermier was present for the reading of Ordinance # 824. Mr. Snyder was making inquiries into the purchase of the quarry property owned by Agri ventures LLC. Mr. Snyder was informed that the Village Solicitor would be the person he should have his attorney contact on the matter.

Police Chief Bielinski presented the end of month report for the police department.

Michael Franklin made a motion that overtime pay at one and half the rate would be paid to full time police officers for any hours over 40. Lisa Skriba seconds the motion.
